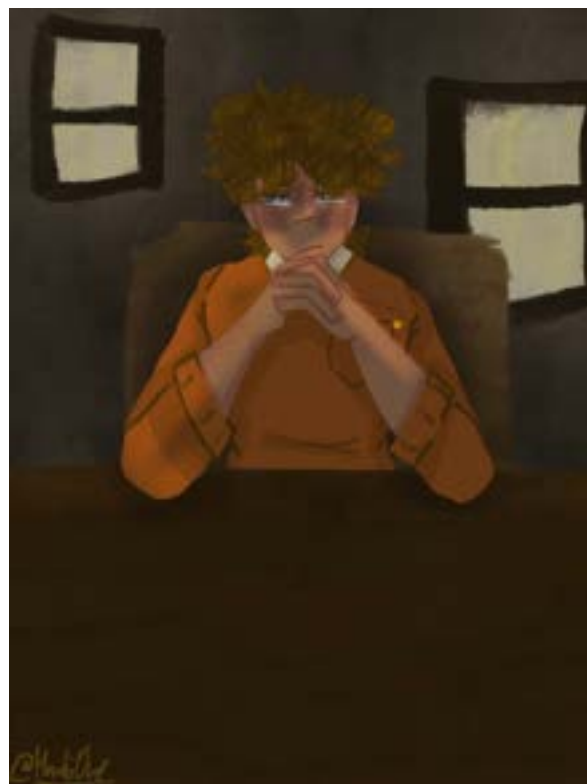

This can be challenging for older or disabled people, and people with mental health issues, such as social anxiety.

In conclusion, concerts can be enjoyable but it is essential to acknowledge the negative aspects. Concert organisers must take steps to address safety concerns, minimize the impact on local communities and make sure that the concert is accessible for everyone.

What am I doing to achieve my goal of becoming a screenwriter?

I personally am trying to be as close to movies as much as I can. I work in a cinema so I can see what people like to watch. I'm looking at the way movies, advertisements and trailers are shot, what angles are shot at, what color schemes do they use to make people watch it. I work on my scripts even though there are times I want to delete it all and just give up. I watch movies and series a lot (basically all the time) and then I talk about them, mostly with my family and friends or on fandom forums etc. And lastly, I make costumes and props for my movie.

Now, here are some of my tips:

- 1) Be original. You can make a sequel, prequel or FanFiction to an already existing movie. But that'll be 1 of millions. Let's be honest, FanFics may be good on Wattpad but unlikely to ever make it on TV. Tell your own stories that have happened to you. Come up with a new Fantasy land, or new demons and ways to die.
- 2) Read. Read. Read. Reading can really help you while thinking about your plot. Read books, movie scripts, short stories.
- 3) WRITE. Write. Write. If you want to finish your work you should work on it as much time as possible, even on days when you hate it.
- 4) Visualize the scenes. It's easier to write when you see what's happening.
- 5) Read what you wrote - you may not like it at first but keep everything, try to add more things to your text or change the words.
- 6) Share your work - let someone else read what you wrote because feedback is so important.

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There Can Only Be One

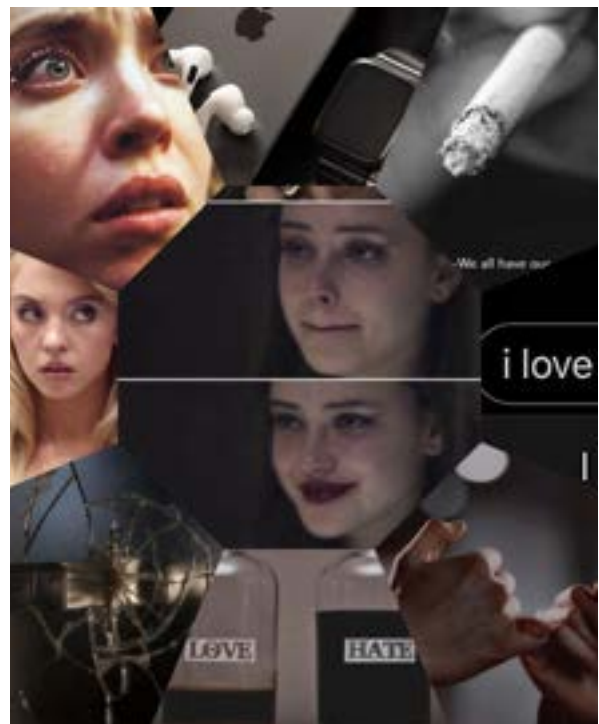

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Game Review

The Last of Us Part I (2022) is a remake of the original The Last of Us (2013). The original game came out for PS3 in 2013 and later in remastered version for PS4 in 2014. The Last of Us is a story-based action which leans heavily on stealth and management of materials and ammunition, which the player can find lying in the post apocalyptic world. The story follows Joel and Elli on their journey across the U.S.A. destroyed by the Cordyceps virus which turns people into zombies.

The remake doesn't change this story, but it aims to improve and modernize gameplay and improve the graphics of the original, making it "the definitive " way to experience this story.

At first glance some of the changes are obvious. The remake brings with it brand new textures for the characters and environments which feature a newer lighting system from The Last of Us Part II. The new environments are more atmospheric, yet their layout hasn't changed. Thanks to the new lighting engine the scenes now convey more emotions and immerse the player more into the game. The same can be said about the new textures which feel more realistic and the characters fit better into the scenes. The remake also features a new HUD which is taken directly from The Last of Us Part II, making it more minimalistic and easier on the eyes.

But let's get to the more controversial part of the game, the gameplay (*see visuals*).

The changes here are almost slim to none. The game incorporates The Last of Us Part II's amazing accessibility systems, making it easier to play the game for not only people with disabilities, but even the people that don't play videogames often. And unfortunately the changes in gameplay end here. It's a bit underwhelming since the developers could have changed the level design a bit to make the levels a bit more vertical than the original. Yet it still manages to improve on the gunplay, the guns now feel much heftier and seem to pack a bit more punch than in the original.

In conclusion, the game features brand new textures and slightly improved gameplay, making it indeed the definitive way to experience the story of The Last of Us. For people who haven't experienced the original game it's an amazing opportunity to experience it for the first time, but for people who have played the original it may not be all too different from the original to warrant the purchase of the remake.

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Metamorphosis

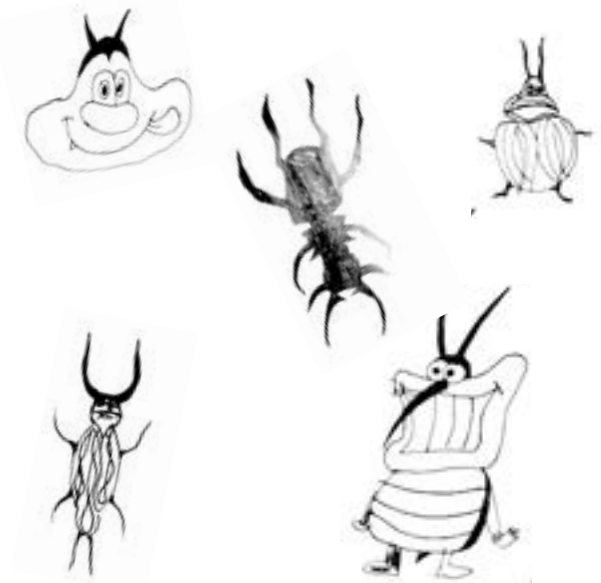

Guardians of the Galaxy: Vol 3

In Marvel Studios' Guardians of the Galaxy: Volume 3, the beloved crew of space castaways take up residence in Knowhere. However, their happy life is soon disrupted by the echoes of Rocket's turbulent past. Still reeling from the loss of his beloved Gamora, Peter Quill must send his team on a dangerous mission to save Rocket's life, a mission where failure could mean the end of the Guardians as we know them.

In the first look at the highly anticipated trilogy capper, we see the Guardians back together, each wearing uniforms that look like they were ripped straight out of the comics. They're a little rusty since most of them have been gone for five years after Thanos (Josh Brolin) snapped them out of existence in Avengers Infinity War, as evident of the alien hostility on an Earth-like suburban neighborhood. We also see that the team's music tastes have matured a bit, as the song playing over the trailer is from the 90s with *In the Meantime* by Spacehog.

We still see that the team is aggressively hysterical, but also that this will be an emotional journey. The key focus is being placed on the origins of Rocket (Bradley Cooper), his history with the new villain the High Evolutionary (Chukwudi Iwuji), and the reveal that Rocket's longtime otter love from the comics, Lylla, will be in the film. We also get a very brief glimpse at the classic comic character Adam Warlock (Will Poulter), but his role in the plot is still a total mystery.



Someone on social media pointed out, that when the Guardians are in space, jumping out of their ship in those colorful space suits, it almost looks like they took the design from popular game *Among Us*.

Honestly, I really am looking forward to this movie. It might be something similar to *Spiderman: No Way Home* - full of action, funny scenes and of course a big emotional rollercoaster! The costume designs look amazing (can't wait to make my new cosplay outfit for the premiere) . I'm pretty sure I'm not the only one who missed Gamora, adorable Mantis in blue and Drax who is both aggressive and goofy at the same time.

Everything looks right except for the new Groot. For those who don't know, this Groot is not the one who was in GOTG Volume 1 (2014). This is his "child" and that's why he looks so different and we all can agree, it's not the best idea they came up with. I still hope fans will be satisfied by this movie because currently there have been more complaints about everything since Phase 4 started (with some exceptions like *Moon Knight*, *Loki*, *Spiderman: No Way Home* or *WandaVision*).

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Recipe

Chocolate Chip Cookies

Ingredients:

300 g all purpose flour
250 g unsalted butter
150 g brown sugar
75 g sugar
2 eggs
1/2 tsp baking soda
1/2 tsp salt
200 g chocolate chips

Bake 8-10 minutes
180 degrees Celsius

Mix room temperature butter with with sugar,
then add the eggs and mix again.

After that put in flour, baking soda, salt and mix
everything together well.

Lastly put your chocolate chips in the mixture.

Make about 50 grams of big pieces of dough.
Place them on a baking tray with baking paper
and press them down.

Put in the oven for 8-10 minutes (until golden).
